Respected Sir,

Subject: Request for provision of Aircondition facility for all Departmental post offices- reg.

My Federation would like to draw your kind attention to the alarming increase in temperatures due to changing weather conditions and the repeated warnings regarding global warming. Under these conditions, employees as well as members of the public are facing considerable difficulties.

Many banks and other Government organisations are providing centralized air-conditioning or air-conditioner facilities in their offices, but in our Department, such facilities are not available in many offices. During peak summer, temperatures of around or above 45°C are being witnessed in many States. The drastic hike in temperature is effecting the health condition of employees badly.

A better working environment will certainly help to increase the efficiency of employees and improve the quality of service to the public. Being a model employer organisation, our Department should take serious note of this issue and provide **centralized air-conditioning for bigger offices and air-conditioners for smaller offices.**

Recently, in each Circle, five Post Offices were identified and renovated under "Jan Sewa Connect." However, even in such renovated offices, air-conditioning facilities have not been provided. My Federation feels that such renovation is also required for the remaining Post Offices, along with air-conditioning facilities.

In view of the above, my Federation requests that the matter may kindly be taken up with the Ministry of Finance through the Hon'ble Minister of Communications (MoC) and Hon'ble Minister of State for Communications (MoSC) for allotment of sufficient funds to provide air-conditioning facilities in all Departmental Post Offices as well as Administrative Offices.

An early action on this subject will be highly appreciated.
