W.r.t the Directorate Letter cited under reference regarding review of Relative Merit Points Scheme for Compassionate Appointments it is to emphasize the following.

1. Previously the Cases were being considered for 5 times, now it is reduced to 3 times. It will certainly reduce the probability of compassionate appointment to the dependents. Hence the same should be reviewed and 5 chances may restored keeping in view of the difficulties facing by the deceased family members.
2. With reference to the letter cited above it is mentioned that amounts received in respect of PLI/RPLI are also being considered in calculation of points. In fact it is the amount given on payment of premium by the officials for insuring this life. The amounts will be paid on par with eligible General Insurant who are not in Service of this Department. Sometimes the nominee of the Policy may not be dependent family member. It may also discourage the officials taking PLI Policy by paying premium. The officials may opt for other insurance policies.

It is to request to relax the above conditions with empathy in respect of Compassionate Appointments in favour of officials.
