Sub:- Settlement of TA claims of the officials deputed for training at PTC, Mysore.

It is brought to the notice of the undersigned that TA claim of the officials who are deputed to undergo training in PTC, Mysore is not being settled in accordance with GOI decision (3) 2 below SR 164 of TA Rules. This is causing monetary loss to the trainees who have paid the charges for boarding and lodging at the rate fixed by PTC, Mysore. As all the training programs in PTC, Mysore are residential, boarding and lodging at training institute is compulsory, the TA claims may be allowed as per the above rules. No modification to the above orders is given in the VI CPC.

Extract of the GOI decision(3) 2 below SR 164 is reproduced below for information :

" In all cases of Government sponsored training programs which are residential and where boarding and lodging at the training institute are compulsory and are provided at fixed rates, a special allowance in lieu of daily allowance will be admissible to Government servants deputed to undergo such training courses. The special allowance, irrespective of the period of training course, will be calculated as follows:-

- a. Out station participants - Actual expenditure on board and lodging plus $\frac{1}{4}$ th of full DA.**
- b. Local participants - Actual expenditure on board and lodging only."**

This may be brought to the notice of all concerned for uniform settlement of TA claims of the officials.
