Federation is very much thankful to both Hon'ble Minister for Communication & IT and Hon'ble Secretary Posts for great initiative steps for filling up of all vacant posts under Mission Recruitment 2023. Since last year appointments letters are issuing to the candidates by holding "Rojgar Mela" in every circle as a prestigious program.

It came to my Federation notice that Department is spending nearly Rs.20 Lakh for holding 'Rojgar Mela' without allotment of any Fund to meet the said expenses and due to this Circle are compelled to utilize PO OE fund for Rojgar Mela purpose resulted adequate shortage in PO OE.

Hence I request the Hon'ble Secretary Posts, kindly intervene in this issue and take up the problem with Hon'ble MOC and Hon'ble Finance Ministries to allot separate fund for holding "Rojgar Melas" and also sufficient PO OE and other important funds like TE, Medical etc as projected by the Circles.

An early action will be highly appreciated.

Due to non filling up of vacant posts in various cadres for the years 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 and 2022-2023 the staff were facing much difficulties in discharging their duties. Ex. In Group A& B cadre- 02, Non Gazetted Gr B- 163. Isolated Posts- 02, MTS 25 and Dept Canteen 5 total 195 posts are lying vacant and 62 are in Position out of Sanctioned strength 257. Hence these posts also may please be included in Mission recruitment Policy 2023.
- 2. Since 14.7.2021 no regular Director PLI, Kolkata available hence the post may please be filled up immediately on century old office.
- 3. It is also suggested to setup Investment Division work infrastructure in the O/o Director PLI Korkata as net accretion for investment and preparation of financial review work is being done at this office.
- 4. Holding of Departmental quota examination for MTS officials against DR quota for the year from 2016 to 2023.

Hence in view of the above I request the Hon'ble D G Posts kindly take immediate action on priority basis.

Sub: Upgradation of bandwidth of NSP-1 links to minimum 2 Mbps (MPLS/VPNoBB)

Sir/Madam,

References have been received from the Circles and Parcel Directorate regarding challenges being faced by field units (Post Offices and Mail Offices) in handling operations due to low network bandwidth. The matter has been examined in consultation with BSNL.

In-principle approval for bandwidth upgradation of NSP-1 Links (MPLS and VPNoBB) to minimum 2 mbps has been conveyed to BSNL for its immediate implementation. Further, bandwidth upgradation of NSP1 MPLS link at DC & DR has also been carried out from existing 1 gbps to 2 gbps to tide over the problems being faced by the field units.

BSNL has also issued directions, vide letter dt. 24.7.2023 (copy enclosed), to their Telecom Circles regarding providing directions to the BSNL field units for urgent upgradation of existing lower bandwidths MPLS links (<2 mbps) of the Department of Posts (DOP) to 2 mbps. Directions for upgradation of VPNoBB links is also being issued by BSNL.

It is requested to monitor the bandwidth upgradation activity in coordination with BSNL and submit line of confirmation to this office.

Sub: Regarding implementation of common bagging of Parcels.

This is regarding effective implementation of common bagging of parcels by parcel Hubs in the country.

- 2. Vide Parcel Directorate letter no. 27-27/2021-PD dated 03.10.2022, detailed instructions regarding implementation of common bagging were issued to all the circles. Circles were advised to use a common bag including all types of Parcels including Speed Post Parcel where the transmission mode is surface and a separate Parcel bag containing Speed Post Parcels where the transmission is through air directly or through intermediate TMOs / Bag Exchange Points. Several instances of mixing up of Speed post parcels with other kind of parcels have been received from Karnataka Circle. (Letter Copy Enclosed).
- 3. Circles were also requested to ensure availability of YELLOW colour bag labels in Parcel Hubs / BNPLs with direct bagging facilities so that the same may be used while closing the bags to be transmitted through air.
- 4. During inquiry of delay in transit in case of Speed Post Parcels, it has been noticed that Speed Post Parcels are being closed in common bag with blue colour bag label even for locations for which direct air connectivity is available. This results in mis-routing / delay in delivery of Speed Post Parcels and sometimes the parcels get lost during transmission.
- 5. In view of the above, Circles are once again requested to ensure the proper implementation of common bagging of parcels in the circles so that such cases can be avoided.
- 6. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
