Respected Sir,

On behalf of the Federation of National Postal Organisations & National Union of Gramin Dak Sevaks we are submitting herewith a Memorandum in respect of the Gramin Dak Sevaks in Department of Posts.

We are requesting you to consider all legitimate claims of Gramin Dak Sevaks in Department of Posts as clearly explained in first 91 pages of memorandum in detail and the summary of total memorandum submitted in nutshell with 54 points from pages 92 to 100. GDS is a neglected sector since 1929 had and no consideration in last 5 enquiry committees, though 4th committee i.e. headed by Justice Chandrajit Singh Talwar considered all legitimate demands of GDS in his report, but was not accepted by the Government upto 90% of the report. As such the burning issues of GDS remained unchanged and hence this memorandum.

The Federation of National Postal Organisations & National Union of Gramin Dak Sevaks have high hopes on the Committee headed by you as Chairman of the Committee. We hope that while recommending wage structure etc. of the GDS. Those recommended by the VIIth CPC to regular employees will be taken in the consideration.

This is the 6th ED/GDS Committee which you may be presiding. The 1st Pay Commission treated the EDAs as Government Servants and so no ED Committee was appointed. The 1st ED Committee Report and while appreciating the constraints with the Government and your own constraints, as you have to submit a balanced report, you can, if you find justification, accept all the points where money is not involved and where money is involved you can act taking into consideration the conditions of the Gramin Dak Sevaks which you know better. Today the entire GDS remember Justice Talwar Tomorrow, we are sure; the GDS will remember you forever.
