Appeal to FNPO colleagues to help our Kerala colleagues

Dear colleagues,

You would have seen in media and social media how Kerala is affected by the recent unprecedented rains.

Unfortunately, the deadliest deluge in Kerala in close to a century has claimed nearly 400 lives. Dozens of people are missing and 1.2 million are sheltering in the relief camps while thousands were stranded in their homes without food and requirements. FNPO expresses its deep concern and empathy with the disaster affected people of Kerala facing unprecedented flood in the state. Immediately on hearing the disaster, Federation contacted Kerala leaders and extended our fraternal solidarity and guidance and brought to notice to leaders of other circles. Various NGOs are extending help in the form of food, money and medical support. Keeping in view the intensity and magnitude of the floods and landslides, this calamity is a severe one and all the present assistances are not sufficient. Simultaneously, The Chief Postmaster General of Kerala was vigilant round the clock monitoring the condition of postal families and assets spreading all over Kerala and rolled out a campaign to collect food and other items. A number of postal fraternities from inside and outside circle have come forward to extend the helping hand to flood-ravaged Kerala. As per the official information, hundreds of post offices and postal families are affected by the flood.

The Chief Postmaster General, Kerala Circle has appealed to mobilize a fund for the relief activities and rehabilitation of postal families. Is it not our duty to help our colleagues when they are in need . We are also braced for the gigantic task of reconstruction of destroyed infrastructure and rehabilitation of postal families.

FNPO requests all the Divisional Secretaries of our affiliated unions to mobilize maximum amount from our members and send the same directly to KERALA POSTAL RELIEF FUND through the national ebiller ID 15017 for the benefit of the Postal fraternity.
