Sub:Aadhar Updation Counters - Regarding

Most of the Circles have opened Aadhar Updation counters in almost all the Departmental Post Offices. The Chairman, Postal Board is aware of the fact that there is an acute shortage (nearly 40%) of PA Staff in all the circles. In practice, it is becoming very difficult even to sanction a day's casual leave to the staff. Further, from the existing aadhar updating counters at post offices, the further modification of single aadhar card data requires at least 15 to 20 minutes. Even after sparing a full-time PA for this counter only 40 to 50 transactions can be done in a day.

Thus, considering the present staff position, the proposed additional time-consuming work will further deepen the problems in day to day working of the post offices and also may lead to grievances of our customers. Hence it is requested not to open such counters in all the departmental post offices, unless and until all the vacancies are filled up. As per departmental and Govt of India Policy, such counters may be opened in selected big post offices such as HOs, MDGs & Taluka Places by providing additional manpower for this work.
