Respected Madam,

Sub: - Allotment of Funds - GDS allowances - GDS substitutes - Reg.

My Federation wishes to bring to your kind notice about non availability of Funds to Charge for the substitutes worked in the leave/vacant posts.

In almost all Circles, the sufficient funds are not yet allotted and the substitutes are facing problems much. The officials who actually worked and not getting single rupee of financial benefit is nothing but violation of rights as per Indian Constitution.

During the last periodical meeting we raised the same issue and Hon'ble Secretary madam directed no one should suffer for wages for the period whom they performed duty. Accordingly instructions issued to charge the substitute salaries can be drawn from the allowances GL code also.

With that orders many got wages but the budget gone for minus. For example AP circle projected for 70 Cr additional funds where AP is running with minus 30Cr. The same is going on in all other circles.

In Telangana circle since one year substitutes are not getting salaries because of non approving the substitute arrangement orders more than the limit which require approval by CPMG is not allowed. Though unions had taken up with circle but no positive humanity step from the Telangana circle.

Hence my federation requests the Hon'ble Secretary post immediately intervene in this issue and cause to supply sufficient fund for GDS substitute salaries and also requested to issue instructions to the CPMG Telangana for taking steps to pay allowances to the substitutes immediately. Further same may kindly resolved in the case of DRM wages in RMS units.
