Sub: - Request for Reconsideration of Non-Acceptance of LSG Declinations Due to Personal Reasons – Reg.

With reference to subject cited above, I respectfully urge the authorities to reconsider the decision regarding the non-acceptance of declinations submitted by officials promoted to the LSG cadre. Several officials, due to compelling personal reasons, are unable or unwilling to assume their new roles, and it is requested that the relevant orders be kept in abeyance until a final resolution is reached.

In this regard, I draw your attention to the Directorate's instructions issued vide Letter No. X-20/28/2023-SPN-II dated 24.09.2024, which reiterates the guidelines from their earlier communication dated 23.07.2024. The Directorate has clearly outlined that declinations from officials unwilling to accept promotions due to personal circumstances, such as relocation to distant locations, should be permitted. Furthermore, it has been advised that supplementary DPCs be conducted for all cadres, including LSG, HSG-II, and HSG-I, in line with the prescribed instructions.

Despite these directives, it has come to our attention that the non-acceptance of declinations is still being enforced. The PMG, HQR, through mail instructions dated 19.02.2025, has upheld this stance, causing undue distress among affected individuals.

In light of the above, I sincerely request your kind intervention to ensure that all declination requests are duly considered in accordance with the Directorate's instructions. A timely and compassionate resolution to this matter would be greatly appreciated.
